The **METRONext: Moving Forward Plan** is all about creating a more modern transit system – and it all begins with accessibility.

Universal Accessibility (UA) is METRO's multi-year construction program designed to ensure bus stops meet or exceed standards laid out in the Americans With Disabilities Act.



METRO's **UA** program will provide safer, more convenient access to METRO's services with an emphasis on bus stop upgrades that will enhance accessibility regardless of age, size, ability or disability.



Upgraded bus stops promote safe and easy boarding



Improved sidewalks offer better walkability and accessibility for individuals in wheelchairs or with strollers



Raised curbs provide added protection for riders from passing vehicles and makes it easier for riders to board and disembark the METRO vehicle.
